MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: High School Diploma or GED. Strong customer service skills. Ability to prioritize multiple tasks. Able to work with minimal supervision in a public setting with multiple employees and distractions. Ability to lift up to 70+ pounds on a consistent basis. Professional appearance and demeanor; attention to detail and accuracy at all times. Able to tolerate odors and chemicals associated with aircraft operations.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Airline reservations, ticketing, passengers/baggage check-in, freight air waybills, route freight, load/unload aircraft, written and verbal communications between all airline departments.
