This announcement is for a Ramp Service Technician with Ravn Air Group. This position reports to the Lead Mechanic/Maintenance Supervisor for Ravn Alaska and is responsible for performing a variety of tasks supporting the maintenance staff. The successful candidate will have a strong work ethic, the ability to follow instructions, and excellent communication skills.

This is a non-exempt, full time, benefits-eligible position. Position typically works four 10-hour days and must be able to work the overnight or early morning shift after training.

Minimum Qualifications

- High School Diploma or GED required;
- Must have a current Alaska Driver's License and clean driving record;
- Must be 100% committed to working safely and following processes and procedures;
- Requires a dependable and motivated individual who is not challenged by working at heights;
- A great work ethic and professional appearance and demeanor are required;
- Good communication, reading, and writing skills are necessary for success;
- A basic proficiency with computers, including Microsoft Outlook and Word is required;
- Must be able to access distances and be able judge objects fitment into reserved spaces;
- A desire to learn and a positive attitude will provide opportunity for advancement;
- Must be open to working in inclement weather, and be able to work the night shift or an early morning shift after training;

- Requires a strong safety awareness and the ability to adhere to Safety Management Systems (SMS);
- Able to pass a comprehensive background check;
- Comfortable working in an airport environment around odors and sounds typically associated with operating aircraft.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Performs and documents daily, weekly, monthly and quarterly hangar inspections;
- Performs aircraft marshalling to include wing walking, aircraft towing and parking. Moves multiple aircraft into hanger nightly for maintenance operations. Launches or receives multiple aircraft for first flights/last flights of the day;
- Applies Rain-X and Ice-X to aircraft under the direction of Lead Mechanic;
- Positions oil fired heaters, applying heat to aircraft cabin interiors in winter;
- Performs the safe operation of Ground Support Equipment (e.g., Tugs, Tow Bars, Ground Power Units, Genie Lift Platforms, Fuel Oil-Fired Heaters, etc.) in launching and during maintenance on aircraft, according to company policy;
- Performs fueling of ground equipment;
- Manages the upkeep and maintenance for building/hanger floor and grounds. Completes some janitorial tasks such as taking out trash and the operation of floor scrubber/polishing machine;
- Promotes the Company safety culture; reporting all service irregularities immediately to supervisor;
- Other duties as assigned and within the scope of this position.
