This announcement is for a Sales Representative for RavnAir Group. This position reports to the Director of Sales and is responsible for representing the Commercial department at a local level, developing sales, customer, and community relations on behalf of RavnAir Group. The successful candidate will have a previous sales background, ideally in aviation in Alaska, excellent communication skills, and the ability to meet deadlines.

This is an exempt, full time, benefits-eligible position. Though this position is based in Anchorage, regular travel to remote airport locations, which includes overnight stays in rural Alaska, will be required.

Minimum Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Marketing, Business or related field is highly preferred;
- Previous charter and sales operations experience in the aviation sector or other relevant aviation experience is highly desired;
- Must have professional experience in a fast-paced environment;
- Demonstrated track record of achievement in sales, marketing, and customer service is highly desired;
- Demonstrated excellence in creating high levels of customer satisfaction, with a strong liking for and effectiveness in dealing with current or potential customers, building trust-based relationships and translating those relationships into profitable, enduring transactions;
- Must be able to travel on a weekly basis to remote locations throughout Alaska, and stay overnight;
- Ability to plan and coordinate with multiple departments and locations to create maximum revenue opportunities;
- Familiarity with Alaska geography and remote Alaska communities;
- Detail-oriented with the ability to prioritize multiple tasks and meet deadlines;
- Strong written and verbal communication skills;

- Demonstrates active listening skills and is able to identify solutions to challenges in unique locations;
- Strong computer skills and a high proficiency with Microsoft Office (Excel, Word, and Outlook) is highly desired;
- Must have a valid driver's license with a clean driving record;
- Requires a strong safety awareness and the ability to adhere to Safety Management Systems (SMS);
- Able to pass a comprehensive background check;
- Comfortable working in an airport environment around odors and sounds typically associated with operating aircraft.

- Responsible for representing the Commercial department at a local basis; developing sales, customer, and community relations with all RavnAir Group customer basis;
- Develops relationships with all RavnAir Connect Airport managers and their teams;
- Ensures all commercial priorities are communicated to the airports and providing feedback to the Commercial team;
- Supports all RavnAir Connect Airport managers in all commercial matters;
- Develops relationships with pilot group and Maintenance personnel to provide feedback to Commercial and communicate policy changes;
- Develops and supports day to day relationships with all key local customers and leading community groups in rural Alaska where RavnAir Group flies;
- Supports the charter team on requests from RavnAir Connect markets and customers to maximize revenue for RavnAir Group;
- Supports statewide and regional community events and activities;
- Attends local events as the Commercial Representative of RavnAir Group;
- Coordinates, researches, and provides key input to regarding any relevant Customer Relation issues/complaints from RavnAir Group customers;
- Provides competitive reports and feedback to Anchorage Headquarters Office on RavnAir Connect local pricing and competitive activity of other airlines;
- Communicates with all RavnAir Connect airports on new and changing Commercial changes; pricing, schedule etc.;
- Supports training for all commercial aspects of the RavnAir Connect operations; correct pricing, fees, baggage policies, contractual conditions;
- Provides input for planning route and schedule development for RavnAir Connect;
- Reports on irregular operations that are impacting commercial activity;
- Provides excellent customer service to both internal and external customers with prompt communication and strong attention to detail;
- Responsible for promoting identification and reporting of safety hazards in the work environment or when confronted with an unsafe situation. Promotes a

positive Safety Culture with co-workers and supports the organization in compliance with Safety Management System (SMS);
