This announcement is for a Kenai Airport Supervisor with RavnAir Group. This position reports to the Kenai Airport Manager and is responsible for administration of safe, productive and professional airport operations within designated areas. The successful candidate must have a strong safety culture, the ability to fulfill the physical requirements of the role, and be capable of working in a fast-paced environment.

This is a non-exempt, full time, benefits-eligible position. Position works an irregular schedule in Kenai, however overtime may be required as dictated by business needs.

Minimum Qualifications

- A High School Diploma/GED is required;
- A minimum of two years' experience in a supervisory role, preferably in the airline industry;
- Knowledge of aviation is highly preferred;
- Must be able to work a flexible work schedule with overtime assigned when the operation dictates;
- Able to work with minimal supervision in a public setting, while maintaining focus around multiple employees and distractions;
- Must have a professional appearance and demeanor;
- Requires a high attention to detail and accuracy at all times;
- Must have strong customer service skills;
- Able to prioritize multiple tasks and delegate responsibilities appropriately;
- Requires a strong safety awareness and the ability to adhere to Safety Management Systems (SMS);
- Able to pass a comprehensive background check;
- Comfortable working in an airport environment around odors and sounds typically associated with operating aircraft.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Responsible for the administration of safe, productive, and professional airport operations within designated areas;
- Ensures safety is the top priority at the station, stopping any unsafe acts if seen;
- Complies with all safety requirements pertaining to the safe operations near or around aircraft;
- Provides good customer service to all internal company employees;
- Enforces airport safety standards to include responsibility for daily ramp safety inspections; hazard identifications; assisting with monthly safety meetings; assist in the investigation of accidents/incidents at the Anchorage station, maintaining a safe and secure environment for all employees and customers;
- Responsible for assigned personnel, to include hiring, discipline and termination; staff scheduling and vacation planning; completion of training for assigned duties to include necessary recurrent training
- Ensures employees are performing duties in a safe and efficient manner that complies with Company and regulatory policies and procedures;
- Informs management of any vehicle and building needs to include equipment and/or facility maintenance or repairs, in a timely manner;
- Maintains integrity of security access to pertinent areas;
- Ensures all applicable badging, OSHA requirements, and pre-hire paperwork are completed and approved in a timely manner;
- Handles stressful and complicated situations as they arise in a calm and professional manner;
- Responsible for promoting identification and reporting of safety hazards in the work environment or when confronted with an unsafe situation. Promotes a positive Safety Culture with co-workers and supports the organization in compliance with Safety Management System (SMS);
- Other duties as assigned and within the scope of this position.
